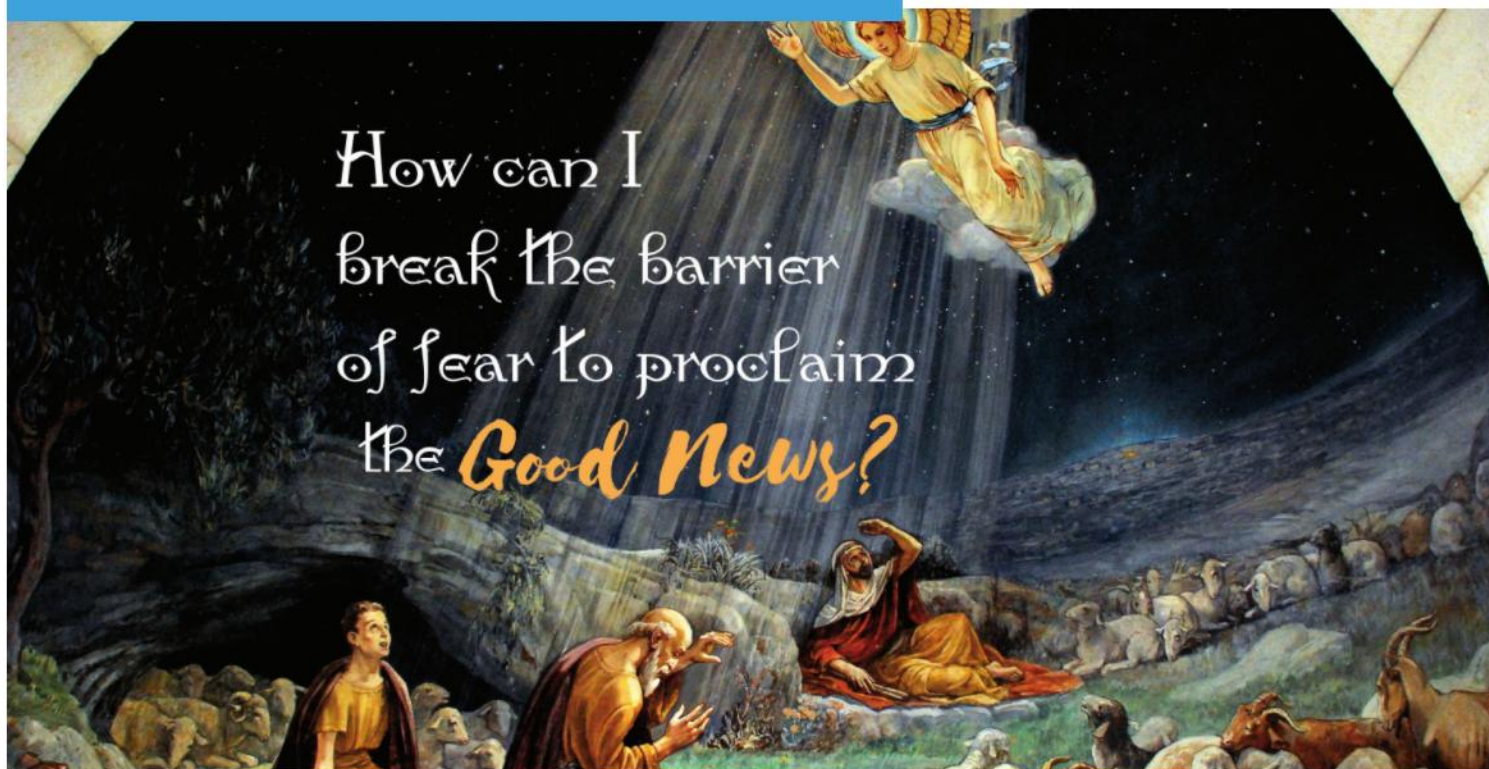

"I PROCLAIM TO YOU GOOD NEWS OF GREAT JOY!

We remind you that the Christmas Season begins at 4:00 PM on Christmas Eve and continues through the Solemnity of the Baptism of the Lord, which will be celebrated on January 8th this year. The Season includes the bright feasts of the Holy Family on December 31st, Mary, the Mother of God, on January 1st (NOT a holy day of obligation this year as it falls on a Monday), and the Solemnity of the Epiphany on January 7th (liturgically, the brightest feast of the entire season), and finally the Baptism of the Lord on January 8th. Please plan on joining for the celebration of these joyful feasts as we continue to rejoice in the Savior's birth. And keep the lights shining, the carols playing, and the hospitality flowing right up to the Baptism of the Lord on January 8th! As mentioned above, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, on January 1st, is not a holy day of obligation this year, since it falls on a Monday. Nevertheless, we encourage you to join us for 10:00 AM Mass New Year's Day to honor Mary and call down God's blessing on the New Year.

THE MODERN EXODUS

It is, I believe, difficult for us, here in the United States especially, to accept that we too are "prisoners" or "slaves". I cannot imagine anything we Americans cherish more than the ideas of FREEDOM. But, if we accept, even in part, the introductory concept that we are impacted by our past experiences, then we are held captive by these experiences (for good or bad). I do not think there is any person ever born, that was born into a family or situation of their own choosing. Some people are born into abject poverty, and some are born into opulent wealth; some people are born into nurturing families, and some are born into grossly abusive families. These are the "fates" of life. Thus, like it or not, we carry the baggage of experiences we have no control of, or choice. We can choose though, we can choose to be mastered by our past, or we can make our own decisions that impact our future. However, and a big however, if we decide to take charge of our own life, we will need to move! The Scriptures never say, but I suspect that there were some Israelites who thought that "freedom from the slavery in Egypt" would not require their leaving home. I can only imagine that some thought freedom would come without a price.

Thus, just as Israel needed to leave the influence of Egypt by physically moving out, leaving behind, literally, home and hearth, to become a new nation; a people of God, we too must move (physically or mentally) out of our "comfort zone" to become a new person, a "person of God". Thus, the whole of the Exodus experience of Israel, from beginning to end, is an eternal story of the struggle of humanity to escape the slavery of sin to become a "people of God". I do not see it a stretch at all to see threads of the Exodus story told and retold throughout the entirety of the Sacred Scriptures. Exodus was not just a "Jewish" experience, it is our experience as well if we are willing to climb out of the slavery to our past.

The Israel of the Exodus had only known an Egyptian way of life. They shared the same religion, the same view of society, the same way of being. The Exodus was not the story of their "escape" as much as it was a story of the new experiences Israel would need to transfer their "fear of god" to accepting a relationship of love and true freedom. The story of the Exodus is an invitation to the whole human race to examine where their false gods are, at which altar of fear do we leave our offerings? We live in a culture greatly impacted by the explosion of the communication industry. We are "marketed" to believe that happiness is ours for the keeping if we would only "buy this..." or "invest in this...". We are being lied to when we are told that we can have "freedom" without sacrifice. We cannot truly have any freedom without sacrifice, nor grow in faith apart from movement. We cannot become new persons and remain as we were. We need to make our own exodus.
