





This week's article is focusing on DB Peru Santa Martha Foundation - Casa Hogar Villa Martha, Pachacamac - Lima Peru as written by Peg Meyer, DB Peru representative.

Casa Hogar Villa Martha is a special place. It's a refuge for physically and emotionally abandoned children who live in this poor region just outside of Lima, Peru where DB headquarters is based. The children receive consistent, loving care in a safe environment. They also receive a strong moral and spiritual foundation that teaches them their value in the eyes of God.

Because they have limited or no family support, it's imperative these children are able to meet life's challenges once they are old enough to leave the home. To help them become responsible adults, Casa Hogar Villa Martha offers many workshops, including farming, sewing, baking, and computer/word processing. This training teaches responsibility, discipline, and the value of hard work. It also builds children's confidence and self-esteem.

Equipment and supplies are needed in all of these programs, and funds to purchase them are limited. Your support would

help these programs continue and flourish, allowing the children to learn new skills they can use for the rest of their lives.

Representatives from DB Peru have had the pleasure of visiting Casa Hogar Villa Martha many times over the years and we have great respect for their work and guiding principles. We support their work and are honored to facilitate donation through our charity that benefits the children living there.
