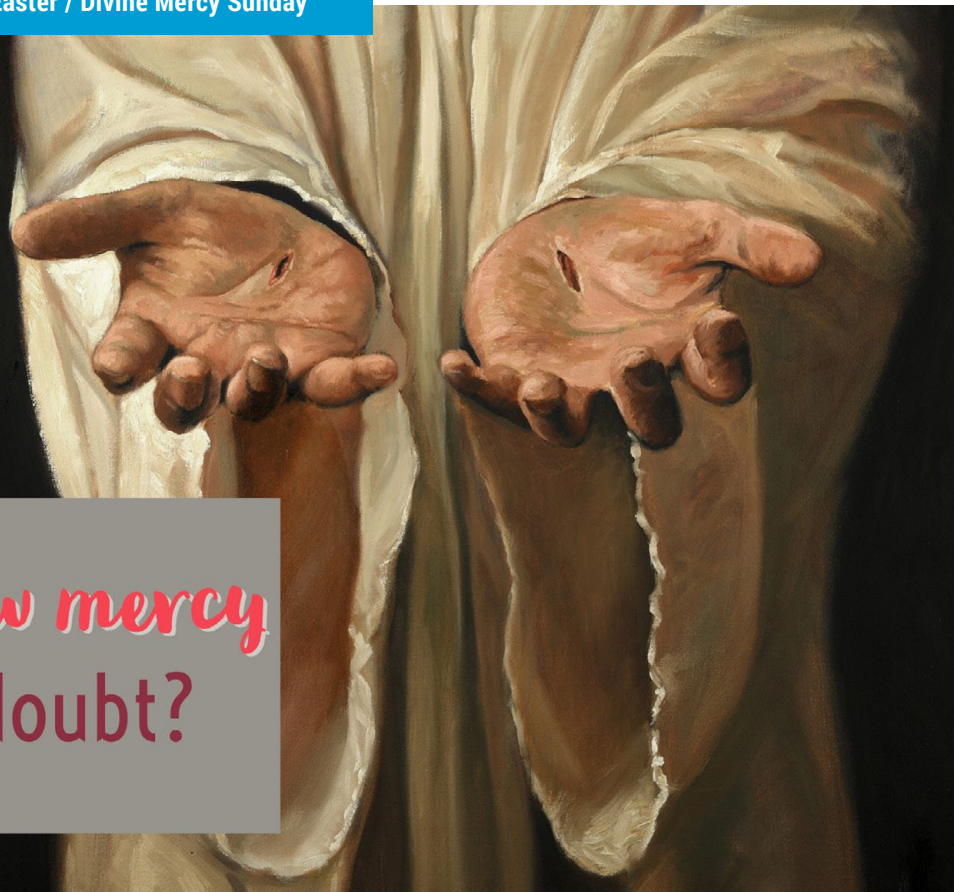

## CONNECTING POINT

### *How Can I show mercy to those who doubt?*

I think we all have people in our lives, often including close friends and family, who are just not ready to believe in Christ. 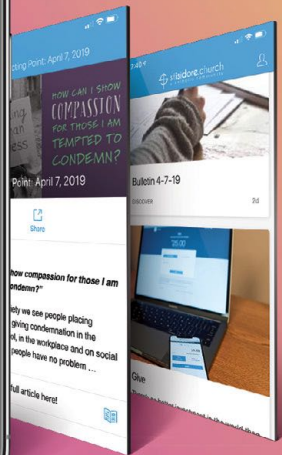

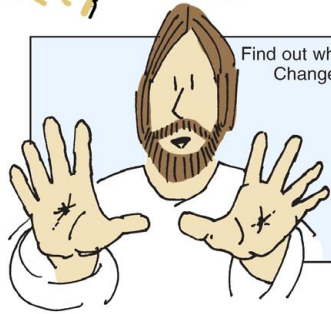

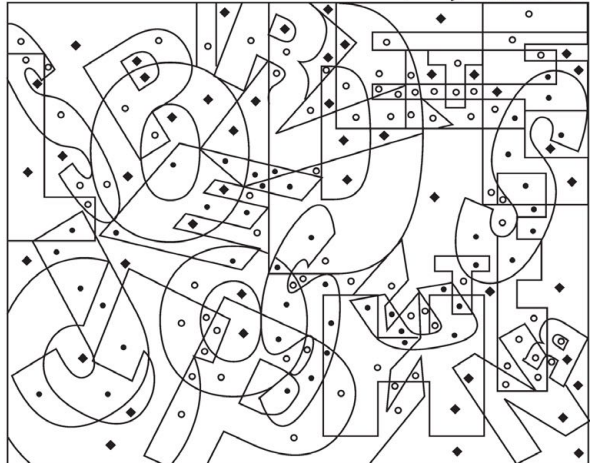
