FR. RON'S REFLECTIONS

Today we celebrate the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as "Gaudete Sunday." Gaudete means rejoice. We rejoice because the coming of Christ is near. The "Sun of Justice" is about to rise and dispel the injustice that darkens the world in which we live. The rose vestments we wear today, the rose candle we light on the Advent wreath, the Advent hangings behind the altar table, and the antependiums (decorative altar cloths) on the table all reflect the beauty of the sky just before dawn. We also see the rising sun on the tapestry on the west wall of our worship space.

In scripture, to be "just" means to live in right relationship with God, with ourselves, with other people, and with all of creation. Breakdowns in any of those relationships bring darkness into our lives. As we rejoice today, let us take time to reflect on our relationships and what we need to do during the approaching Christmas season to bring healing to those relationships that are broken. How we can grow closer to God in prayer. How we can come to accept our shortcomings and those of others. What prejudices
